What is it?






Government Contractor vs Public Sector

Government Contractor:





- May also provide goods or services to commercial businesses
- Can be private equity backed, publicly traded or owner operated
- Can operate in virtually any industry









What Is Government Contracting?

The US Federal government is the largest consumer in the world with complex acquisition, compliance, invoicing, and reporting requirements.

The US Federal Government obligates over \$700 Billion dollars per year for spending with government contractors

Government outlays accounted for 20.2%-23.4% of US GDP between 2010-2019. Outlays increased to 31.2% and 32.9% of GDP in 2020 and 2021 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic

Government contracting is lucrative but highly regulated and requires significant regulatory compliance

Government Contractors rely on purpose-built ERP systems to manage their cost, contract, business process, and cybersecurity compliance.
