1.0 BACKGROUND. The Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division (NAWCAD), System Engineering Competency (AIE-4.1) is tasked to provide reliability, maintainability, system safety, diagnostics, and testability support of Naval aircraft and their subsystems.

2.0 SCOPE. This IDIQ contract vehicle will permit specific task orders to be issued, based on the general tasking outline in Section 4.0. 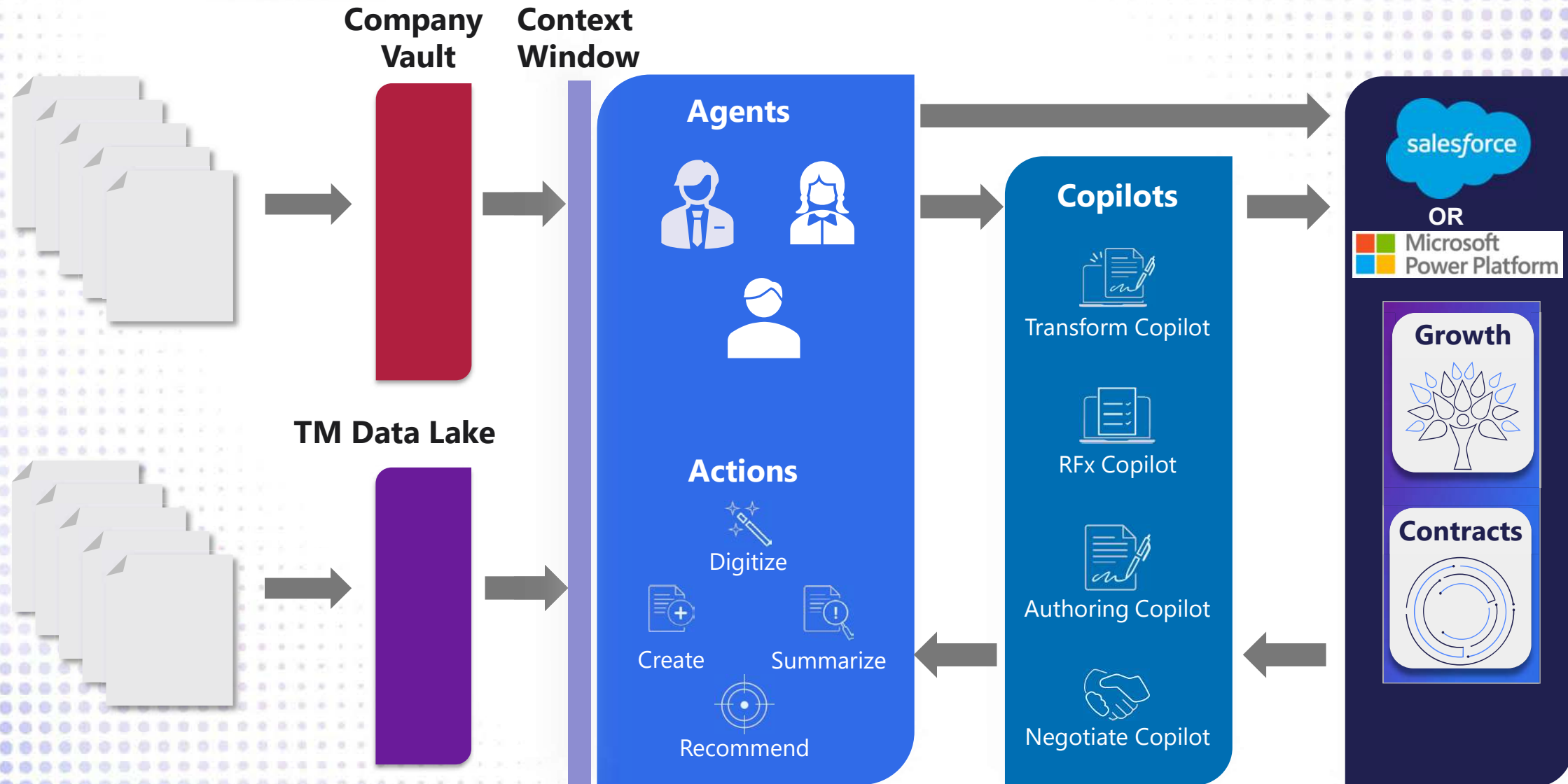
